Home Secretary reviews CISF security preparedness

In his welcome address Addl.DG, CISF appraised about the action taken on decisions taken during last Operational Conference and urged the participants that the remaining issues be sorted out immediately. Further, he emphasized upon the units which have not been inspected in the last two years by any senior officers, be inspected in the prescribed time frame regularly.

DG in his address greeted all officers and stressed the need for redressal of grievances of personnel. Various security and operational matters were discussed during the conference.

DG also underlined the importance for strengthening of CIW staffs in field formations to make it quite effective and result oriented. It was advised that Units falling in naxal affected areas be visited by Sector IsG and zonal DisG and other senior officers from time to time to boost up the morale of the force personnel.

Shri E.Sreedharan, CMD, DMRC visited CISF HQrs as a guest of honour and interacted with the officers. Shri Sreedharan emphasised on cardinal fundamentals of success for government officers namely Professional competence, Integrity, Punctuality and accountability.

He also stressed that we need not forget our social responsibilities. He cited an example of the design of Delhi Metro Platforms which were constructed keeping in mind for their being user friendly, especially to the disabled. He emphasized that CISF personnel at DMRC need to help the physically challenged commuters whenever they come across them.

Shri Sreedharan remembered his long association with the CISF when headed the Cochin Port Trust long back and felt that high moral values should be followed while dealing with such Sectors wherein public interaction is of paramount importance. He expressed his happiness that the Force has done an excellent job since induction at Delhi Metro and that 4,500 CISF personnel across the entire network of the Delhi Metro, are guarding this national asset.
